ORDER:

Government issued orders in the G.O. first read above for the Welfare of the Backward Classes in Andhra Pradesh and also Keeping in view the recommendations by the Chief Engineer (MTWS) for utilization of Acatia Trees available in Tank beds during the adverse seasonal condition.

2. It has been represented that certain Gram Panchayats are putting such trees for auction instead of giving to the shepherds and the sheperds are facing trouble to graze their sheep, and requested to issue instructions for stopping the system of auctioning such trees.

3. Government after careful examination of the issue with reference to certain concessions granted to the Cooperative Societies in connection with fishing rights in the Gram Panchayat tanks direct that the following conditions be followed for leasing up the Acatia trees to the shepherds Cooperative Societies for grazing the Sheep.

1. The Gram Panchayat should identify the Acatia trees in the tank beds in Panchayat limits and not the trees in other lands other than tank bunds and tank beds.
2. The Divisional Panchayat Officer has to be addressed to fix up upset price and the Divisional Panchayat Officer has to fix the minimum upset price within a week and intimate to the Gram Panchayat.
3. The Gram Panchayat in turn should intimate the upset price to the Shepherds Cooperative Society for their acceptance.
4. If no acceptance is received from the Society within a reasonable period, say about one week, then only the Gram Panchayat shall put the Acatia trees to public auction for one year and for periods not exceedings three years at a time in all leases given to Shepherds Cooperative Societies.
5. There should be a condition for leasing or auction that the lease holder/highest bidders should utilize the trees for grazing the sheep only and not for any other purpose and the main trunk or branches should not be affected.

4. The District Panchayat Officers are requested to follow the above conditions regarding letting out the Acatia trees for grazing.
